- 5. Arrangements for the use of a condominium or other privately owned property are subject to agreement between the donor and the buyer. All accommodations and transportation are subject to availability. The Committee and PCS are not responsible for donor representations.
- 6.Once a bid is made, it cannot be withdrawn.
- 7. Invalid bids can be nullified, but only by an authorized Committee member. Criteria for nullifications are:
 - a. Lack of minimum bid
 - b.Incorrect minimum bid increment
- 8. In the event of a dispute, the Committee shall act as final authority and determine the winning bid.
- 9. Any winner who has not made arrangements for payment prior to the end of the Auction will forfeit his/her right to the auction item.

BIDDING GUIDELINES & TIPS

SILENT AUCTION

- Review the items available for Silent Auction
- Place your bid at https://santorinigala.givesmart.com
- The minimum bid requirement and the minimum increment are automatic
- Check your alerts and messages for bidding updates
- Bidding will close at 9:30pm
- The highest bidder will be notified via email and text

LIUE AUCTION

- Live Auction items will be on display on the auction website and in a Powerpoint Presentation
- Use your paddle to indicate your desire to bid on the item at the price called out by the auctioneer
- There are spotters located throughout the ballroom to assist the auctioneer during the bidding activity
- The auctioneer will identify the winning bid. As each item is sold, the winning bid will be recorded and the winner will confirm with his/her signature
- All auction items purchased must go home with the buyer this evening as there is no storage available
